**Annual B-CC High School Used Book Sale**

*Showcasing the culmination of a month-long school/community literary and arts collaboration along with thousands of books for sale*

On Sunday, March 25, the Bethesda Chevy Chase High School (BCC) PTSA hosts its annual Used Book Sale and Café from 11:00 am until 4:00 pm at the school. The book sale features thousands of gently used (and in some cases, new), hardcover and paperback books. Newberry and Caldecott award winning children's books, Pulitzer and National Book award winners, popular authors including Grisham, Follett, and Clancy, as well as hundreds of history books, biographies, art books, and cook books are sorted and categorized. Hard covers are priced at \$2.00; paperbacks, \$1.00 and all monies raised support the B-CC PTSA.

This year, the popular community event is part of an exciting new literary arts festival. Writers like Valerie Tripp, author of many books in the *American Girl* series, Hilton Als, theater critic for *The New Yorker*, and other local and nationally known authors will be working with B-CC students throughout the month of March. At the used book sale, we will showcase the work that students have produced in this collaboration and offer readings, an art show, and activities for children. There will also be live entertainment provided by B-CC musicians and an opportunity to donate books to Club Read, a student-initiated volunteer effort that promotes literacy in the local community. Books written by B-CC students, parents, alumni, and staff will be on display.

The B-CC PTSA supports a broad range of programs at the school. Extracurricular clubs, student publications, the student directory and parent newsletter are just some of the important contributions the PTSA makes in support of the B-CC community.
